

# Sheep Gift Cards

## Introduction

The symbol of a sheep has become part of the celebrations for Eid ul-Adha, which this year takes place around 20th July.

These charming sheep gift cards can be used at any time of year, especially for anyone from a farming background, but at this time of year use the inside to wish everyone 'Eid Mubarak'.

Involve as many residents as possible in making the cards and chatting about Eid ul-Adha. Some may just enjoy the sensory experience of feeling the towel, others will want to put the cards together.

## You Will Need

- Green card
- Black card
- Scissors
- Glue
- Googly eyes or Tippex
- Fine black marker pens
- Old white towel (a great use for towels that are getting just a bit tatty or threadbare!)

## Risk Assess

Care using scissors. Be aware of possible choking hazard if using googly eyes. Care if using Tippex.

## What To Do

Cut out and fold over a piece of green card to form the greetings card.

Cut out an oval of white towel for your sheep's body, a smaller oval of black card for the head, two ears out of black card, and a small bit of towelling for the top of the head.

You can arrange the sheep front facing or to the side (see photos). Glue the towelling and card in place.

Add googly eyes or paint some on with Tippex, putting a black centre with your marker pen.

Draw on the legs with black marker pen.

Add a suitable greeting inside.
